

## Terms of use

The IHS-Library is an open-access library. IHS-staff and students may borrow all materials for four weeks. The loan period may be extended provided no other reader has reserved the material previously. The library has the right to recall any material on loan.

**External users may use the library only as reference library in the mornings or after prior arrangement.**

Library material must be handled carefully. The reader is responsible for the borrowed material(s). Lost or damaged items must be reported promptly. The borrower is requested to pay for replacement.

If a reader leaves the Institute for a longer period, she or he is asked to contact the library.

Users of the library are requested not to eat, drink, smoke or use a mobile phone on the premises.

Two weeks before a staff member or student definitely leaves the Institute, she or he has to return all borrowed library items.

We are storing personal data for the automatic loan system.

By signing the library pass the reader acknowledges the library regulations.

## Electronic Resources

Electronic resources can only be accessed on IHS campus or via VPN.

**By accessing licensed material, users agree to the following terms of use:**

1. Access to electronic full texts is restricted to staff, employees and students of the Institute for Advanced Studies.
2. Full texts may only be printed or downloaded for personal, non-commercial use or for research purposes.
3. Systematic downloads of search results and full texts, particularly using robots or search engines, are not permitted.
4. Full texts may not be made available to third persons in electronic or print form, except to staff, employees and students of the Institute for Advanced Studies.
