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Narrative Description of Research Output:

Stefan Vogtenhuber has published in leading sociology and other journals, such as the *European Sociological Review*, *Research on Social Stratification and Mobility*, *Journal of Vocational Behavior*, *PLoS One*, or *Journal of Family Research*. His research focuses mainly on credential and skill attainment contingent on social origin, occupational outcomes of educational activities and its institutional determinants (early tracking, vocational education and training and the apprenticeship system), and the transition from school to work. He is an expert in quantitative data management and analysis, both comparative and national as well as survey and administrative. He has been teaching quantitative methods and data visualization on undergraduate and graduate level for years. He regularly attends international scientific conferences and is also a member of the expert committees on education, qualification, and the labor market.
